GOVERNMENT TRAVEL MANDATE-EFFECTIVE AUGUST, 1 2020

All travelers entering Massachusetts, both out of state residents and Massachusetts residents returning home, must comply with a new travel order. Travelers must now fill out a *Massachusetts Traveler Form* at <https://www.mass.gov/forms/massachusetts-travel-form> unless they are coming from a state that has been designated a lower risk COVID-19 state or fall into an exemption category. Travelers arriving from a high-risk state must quarantine for 14 days unless they can produce a negative COVID-19 test result administered on a sample taken not more than 72 hours prior to arriving in Massachusetts.

Sun RV Resorts Health & Safety Protocols

At all Sun RV Resorts, we take standards for hygiene and cleanliness very seriously and have taken additional steps to ensure the safety of our guests, and team members.

- For the safety of our guests and team members, if you are feeling ill or have an elevated temperature please stay home.
- All individuals over the age of 5, including team members, residents and guests are required to wear a face covering while inside Sun's facilities. This requirement also extends to outdoor settings where individuals are within 6 ft./2m of one another.**
- Enhanced **cleaning and sanitization protocols** have been established with defined cycles and procedures for common areas, high-touch surfaces, vacation rentals, cottages, and cabins.
- There will be **Ongoing training** for team members as well as daily temperature checks prior to shift start.
- Information regarding recommended **handwashing procedures** will be posted in restrooms, breakrooms, offices, and common areas to increase awareness of simple prevention methods.
- EPA-registered disinfectant products** have been distributed to all locations.

CDC Guidelines

- Avoid close contact and practice social distancing of at least 6 feet.
- Practice frequent hand washing or use of alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others.
- Do not gather in groups and stay out of crowded places and avoid mass gatherings.

Campers Haven RV Resort Re-Opening Guidelines

- All campsites are limited to members of a single household or living unit.
- Registered guests only may enter the resort. Due to state mandate, no visitors are allowed entry. Transient reservations are limited to guests from the same home family unit.**

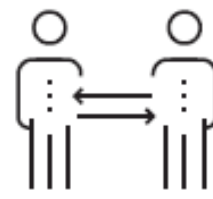
