Sun RV Resorts Health & Safety Protocols

At all Sun RV Resorts, we take standards for hygiene and cleanliness very seriously and have taken additional steps to ensure the safety of our guests, and team members.

- For the safety of our guests and team members, if you are feeling ill or have an elevated temperature please stay home.
- All individuals over the age of 5, including team members, residents and guests are required to wear a face covering while inside Sun's facilities. This requirement also extends to outdoor settings where individuals are within 6 ft./2m of one another.**
- Enhanced **cleaning and sanitization protocols** have been established with defined cycles and procedures for common areas, high-touch surfaces, vacation rentals, cottages, and cabins.
- There will be **Ongoing training** for team members as well as daily temperature checks prior to shift start.
- Informational regarding recommended **handwashing procedures** will be posted in restrooms, breakrooms, offices, and common areas to increase awareness of simple prevention methods.
- EPA-registered disinfectant products** have been distributed to all locations.

CDC Guidelines

- Avoid close contact and practice social distancing of at least 6 feet.
- Practice frequent hand washing or use of alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others.
- Do not gather in groups and stay out of crowded places and avoid mass gatherings.

State of Maine Guidelines

Guests that are **not** residents of Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, New York, New Jersey or Connecticut either need to quarantine at your site or arrive with a negative Covid-19 test that was drawn within 72 hours prior to your arrival. Children (under age18) do not need to get tested, but if any adult in the party is quarantining, then so are the children. Quarantining at home prior to arriving is NOT an alternative to quarantining in Maine. Quarantining at your site means that you are not allowed to use any public facilities - this includes riding the trolley, using the pool or other recreational amenities. All guests that are **not** residents of Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, New York, New Jersey or Connecticut must sign a "Certificate of Compliance". You are welcome to enjoy the outdoors with physical distancing, take walks, have fires at your site, order delivery from the snack bar, and you may leave the campground.

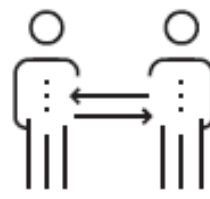
