WHAT SHOULD I DO BEFORE I LEAVE FOR THE SUMMER?

- Disconnect all hoses and cords
- Stow cords, hoses, decorative landscaping, etc... in RV units or shed
- Remove any signs, flags, flower pots and secure in RV units or shed
- Place all grills, ladders, chairs, etc. in sheds
- Prep landscaping by applying heavy weed cloth/weed killer prior to leaving. If you do not wish landscaped areas to be maintained by weed eating over the summer, please contact someone to maintain these areas for you.
- If your unit has steps, please use heavy strapping to secure steps to your RV or place them in your shed. Please mark your steps with a lot number.
- Remember summer months is hurricane season, all sites full-time or seasonal must follow these guidelines without any expectations. Any item left behind will be discarded.
